

**Partners in Flight seeks bird abundance and density info for westside forest birds**

**Deadline: September 18, 2009**

We are looking for any reports/data that provide bird abundance/density information using point counts (fixed or variable radius) or spot-mapping to include in a database for Westside forest bird densities (i.e., western BC, Washington, Oregon and northern California). This information and summaries of it will be provided on the Oregon-Washington Partners in Flight web page for many potential uses but especially calculation of population estimates.

There have been numerous bird studies done, and I suspect we already have the primary well-documented ones in the literature. What I am mostly looking for is unpublished work that has been summarized in a report, but was kept in-house or submitted as to a funder but has not really been dispersed.

You can send me an email to see if I have it or just go ahead and send if it is unlikely I have it. Thanks in advance for contributing. We will get this on the web page this winter.
